

# POISE



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The MEDI module was created to track students' medical records. This information can be transferred from building to building and will be with the student until their records are deleted from SIS.

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## MEDI Screen - Student Medical Information

This screen is used to enter the medical alert, condition information, allergies, dental information, height, weight, medical history, hearing, immunization, medication, Scoliosis results, vision results and other medical information for the student. The contact information can be collected from the PADR - Parent/Guardian address, CONT - Student Contacts and STUD screen.

The contact sub-screen for MEDI is a display only screen. The rest of the sub-screens can be used with the Display, Add, Change or Delete options. Different fields will display depending on what "Type" of screen is selected. The code that is entered into the "Type" field will depend on the sub-screen that is trying to be accessed. Each of the different screen types is explained below.

The social security number, birthdate and age will be automatically filled in from the information on the STUD screen.

To access the MEDI screen in display mode, enter **D MEDI** at the Command: prompt and press <RETURN>. To add you would type **A MEDI**, change is **C MEDI** and delete is **DE MEDI**.

Enter the valid student ID defined on the STUD screen. If you do not know the student ID, press the <DELETE> key for dumb terminals or <BACKSPACE > key for PC's and enter a portion of the name of the student you wish to locate.

Once the student has been identified, you will be prompted to enter a two-character sub-type. If you do not know the sub-type enter in a question mark (?), press <RETURN> and a help box will appear on the lower right hand screen.

## CO - Contacts

For contacts you would enter **CO** under the **Type:** field.

This sub-screen will display the parent's record from STUD and all the PADR records that have a 'Y' in the field 'Display on MEDI:'. This is a DISPLAY only sub-screen.

This screen is used to store the date of the dental information, mouthwash, referral date, and whether special service was received and the findings of the examination. This can be used in display, add, change or delete mode.

## Comments

Enter 3 fields, of 67 characters each, concerning any comments you have about the condition of the student attending the health center.

## Temp

Enter the student's current temperature. Do not enter a period (.) for the tenths of a degree in the temperature. After you press <RETURN>, the temperature will be displayed with the period(.) separating the tenths of a degree.

## Clean/B.A.

Enter a X if the student requires Basic Wound Care.

## R.I.C.E

Enter an X if the student requires Rest, Ice, Compression or Elevation.

## Lice Care

Enter an X if the student requires Lice Care.

## Fem Care

Enter an X if the female student requires Feminine care.

## Rest/Observe

Enter an X if the student needs rest or observation.
